






HOW IS THE BALLOT PAPER MARKED?

VOTERS MUST SELECT ONLY ONE CANDIDATE ON THE BALLOT PAPER BY MARKING THE SQUARE BOX NEXT TO THAT CANDIDATE'S NAME WITH AN (X) WHILE CONSIDERING THAT THE X IS PLACED WITHIN THE

BOUNDARIES
OF THE SQUARE
AND THAT THE
PAPER IS NOT
DAMAGED OR
STAINED WITH
INK.





WHEN WILL THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION TAKE PLACE?

VOTING IN TUNISIA WILL TAKE PLACE ON SUNDAY 23RD OF NOVEMBER 2014. THE VOTING WILL TAKE PLACE OVER ONE DAY ONLY, WHICH WILL BE A PUBLIC HOLIDAY.

VOTING WILL BEGIN AT 8:00 AM AND END AT 18:00 PM





OUT OF COUNTRY VOTING WILL TAKE PLACE OVER THREE CONSECUTIVE DAYS, WHICH ARE THE 21ST, 22ND AND 23RD OF NOVEMBER 2014.

OUT-OF-COUNTRY VOTING WILL BEGIN AT 8:00 AM AND WILL END AT 18:00 PM.

WHERE WILL THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION TAKE PLACE?

VOTERS SHOULD CAST THEIR BALLOTS AT THE POLLING CENTER THAT THEY CHOSE WHEN THEY REGISTERED ON THE VOTERS' LIST. FOR IN-COUNTRY VOTING, POLLING CENTERS ARE LOCATED IN PRIMARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS. FOR OUT-OF-COUNTRY VOTING, POLLING CENTERS ARE LOCATED IN TUNISIAN CONSULATES OR DIPLOMATIC MISSIONS OR ANY OTHER LOCATION ABROAD THAT THE IRIE HAD ANNOUNCED.

FOR IN-COUNTRY REGISTERED VOTERS, YOU CAN USE THE FREE MOBILE SERVICE *195*CIN# TO VERIFY YOUR POLLING CENTER, THE NUMBER OF YOUR POLLING STATION AND YOUR RANK ON THE VOTERS' LIST.

BOTH IN-COUNTRY AND OUT-OF-COUNTRY VOTERS CAN VERIFY THE SAME INFORMATION ONLINE A https://touenssa.isie.tn

WHAT DOCUMENTS SHOULD VOTERS PRESENT AT THE POLLING CENTER?

EACH VOTER MUST PRESENT HIS OR HER NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD (NID) OR PASSPORT AT THE POLLING CENTER.


Electoral observers and candidates' representatives observe the polling process.




Placing the ballot paper inside the ballot box and leaving the polling station and centre









WHAT ARE THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION?

THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION ARE ABOUT ELECTING A PRESIDENT FOR TUNISIA FOR A FIVE-YEAR-TERM. THE PRESIDENT WILL BE ELECTED DIRECTLY BY CITIZENS REGISTERED ON THE VOTERS' LIST AND MUST BE ELECTED WITH AN ABSOLUTE MAJORITY OF VALID VOTES, I.E AT LEAST %50 OF THE VOTES PLUS ONE VOTE.

IN THE EVENT THAT NONE OF THE CANDIDATES ACHIEVE AN ABSOLUTE MAJORITY IN THE FIRST ROUND, A SECOND ROUND WILL BE ORGANIZED DURING THE TWO WEEKS FOLLOWING THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE FIRST ROUND'S FINAL RESULTS. THE TWO CANDIDATES, WHO WON THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES IN THE FIRST ROUND, WILL COMPETE IN THE SECOND ROUND.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC?

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC IS THE HEAD OF STATE, REPRESENTS ITS UNITY AND GUARANTEES ITS INDEPENDENCE AND CONTINUITY AND ENSURES RESPECT OF THE CONSTITUTION.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC?

- 1 REPRESENTING THE STATE
- 2 PRESIDING OVER THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL
- 3 COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF THE ARMED FORCES
- 4 DECLARING WAR AND ESTABLISHING PEACE
- 5 RATIFICATION OF TREATIES
- 6 SUBMITTING FOR REFERENDUM DRAFT LAWS THAT RELATE TO RATIFICATION OF TREATIES, FREEDOMS, HUMAN RIGHTS OR PERSONAL STATUS, WHICH HAD BEEN RATIFIED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF PEOPLE'S REPRESENTATIVES
- 7 PRESENT DRAFT LAWS TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT
- 8 INITIATING PROPOSALS FOR CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS
- 9 INITIATING PROPOSALS FOR DRAFT LAWS TO THE ASSEMBLY OF PEOPLE'S REPRESENTATIVES

WHO HAS THE RIGHT TO VOTE?

ANY TUNISIAN WHO IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AS OF ONE DAY PRIOR TO ELECTION DAY AND WHO IS REGISTERED IN THE VOTERS' LIST AND WHO IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY OF THE LEGAL CONDITIONS THAT DEPRIVE HIM OR HER FROM THE RIGHT TO VOTE.
