



The Voter Information Card (VIC) contains the voters' information from the provisional voter registration database which was based on the 2008 voter registration update. The card was developed to assist the voters in checking their information and update it if necessary

IMPORTANT: The Voter Information Card is for information only and can not be used as an identification document on Election Day.

The information on the VIC is as follows:

- ▶ Governorate Name
- ▶ Full Name
- ▶ Date of Birth
- ▶ Voter Identification Number
- ▶ Family Food Ration Card Number
- ▶ Food Center Number
- ▶ Food Agent Number (Polling Unit Number)
- ▶ Voter Registration Center Number
- ▶ Polling Center Name
- ▶ Polling Center Number
- ▶ Card Serial Number

The back side of the VIC contains instruction on different cases that will require the voter to visit the registration center. The back side also provides the help desk telephone numbers and the IHEC web site address where voters can obtain additional information

All instructions and information titles are printed in Arabic and Kurdish

The VIC was printed on security paper with watermarks images to protect against forge ring

Voter registration centers mobile teams with the assistance of the local food distribution agents were utilized to distribute the VIC.
