

Info bulletin for the representatives of the out of country political entities for the 2010 parliament members' elections.

Every political entity countersigned by the commission is entitled to make an accreditation request for a representative in each of the countries in which the 2010 parliament members elections will take place for the purpose of contacting these countries' offices on behalf of the political entity and finishing all the procedures regarding '' the accreditation of the political entities representatives, getting info and being updated on the centers and stations in that state, getting acquainted of the procedures the commission is taken regarding the political entities.

Accreditation of the political entities' representatives:

1. Every countersigned on political entity should accredit one representative within the country it wishes to accredit a representative in it.
2. The accreditation is done according to the applications prepared by the out of country elections administration office for this purpose, which can be obtained from the National Office / political entities section or out of country office in Erbil or via the I HEC electronic web site: www.ihedq.com
3. Every political entity is held responsible for the well-being and safety of their representatives and all support management and funding, where the commission does not afford any financial responsibilities. Besides, political entities representatives are not allowed to take advantage of any of the commission resources such as: devices and vehicles.
4. An authorization paper is signed by both the political entity president and the authorized accredited representative for

the political entity, attached with it a copy of the authorizing paper for the representative signing on the application.

5. The president of the political entity signs on the application attached to the authorizing paper'' a table of the representative name of the entity in the countries'' and the application is sealed with the political entity's stamp ad / signet.

6. The political entity commits itself to sending a copy of the authorization paper to their representatives in the countries to be shown when contacting the countries' offices.
