## Media Accreditation Application

Applications are invited from members of the media for accreditation to the 2006 General Elections of the Fiji Islands. Applications must meet the following requirements:

# **Mandatory Requirements**

- \* A separate application form MUST be completed for each representative (photocopy original or print from the Internet: www.elections.gov.fj). All sections must be completed to ensure accreditation.
- \* ONE (1) PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOGRAPH (name to be printed on the reverse side) of each individual seeking accreditation must be forwarded with each application form. For those wanting to send digital images (name to be included in digital image file name), please e-mail them to info@elections.gov.fj copied to bdolokoto@info.gov.fj OR rnaco@info.gov.fj
- \* ALL applications MUST be accompanied by a letter from the media organisation represented. This must be on **ORIGINAL** letterhead, signed by either the Publisher, Editor, News Editor, Chief of Staff or equivalent senior editor.
- \* ALL APPLICATIONS are preferably posted and or hand- delivered.

In order for accreditation to be considered, applications must be received NO LATER THAN Friday, April 21, 2006.

\* OVERSEAS JOURNALISTS coming into the country for less than 14 days need not fill out a work permit but to declare on arrival at the Nadi/Nausori airport that you are here on business i.e. 2006 General Elections.

If you will be in the country for more than 14 days, you will need to declare it in your media accreditation so that we can arrange that when you arrive at Nadi/Nausori airport, you will be taken to the Immigration Department for issuance of a work permit.

- \* Applications for media accreditation is free.
- \* When allocating accreditation, **FIRST** priority will be given to **DAILY** press, television, radio, and to specialist news and current affairs publications.
- \* Completion of this form does not guarantee accreditation.
- \*Written confirmation on the status of application will be provided as soon as the application is received.
