ELECTORAL MODERNISATIONTHE UK PRACTITIONERS' PERSPECTIVE

by John Turner

Electoral modernisation in the United Kingdom has followed a somewhat faltering path since its introduction some 10 years ago. The Association of Electoral Administrators (AEA) has taken a keen interest in the



ongoing debate since that time. However, its stance in recent years has become more sceptical largely because modernisation does not appear to have delivered lasting benefits that can be applied in a universal way.

The Ministry of Justice, which is the government department responsible for electoral legislation and policy, defines electoral modernisation as "giving people choice in the way they exercise their vote." Its aim is to develop policies and processes to make elections more accessible, improve participation, enhance security and improve the efficiency and cost-effectiveness of elections. Most of this work in the last decade has been on initiatives such as pilots to test innovations in local elections, and the Co-ordinated Online Record of Electors (CORE) information system, which will provide a single source of electoral registration information to authorised users.

Following the May 2007 elections, the AEA expressed considerable concern that:

 a number of problems were identified with the electronic count and counting procedures at the combined Scottish parliamentary and local government elections¹

- insufficient time was allowed to properly test systems used to identify postal voters by their date of birth and signature
- the Electoral Commission, in a summary report of their evaluation of a sixth electoral pilot since 2000, recommended that a range of significant challenges that arose with both electronic voting and counting systems be addressed²

In the AEA's post-election report following the May 2007 elections, we commented on these issues and expressed considerable concern over their impact on public confidence and the democratic process itself. Similarly, with respect to future pilots at elections, we supported the view of the Electoral Commission that,

"there should be a gap of at least one year before consideration is given to any further piloting of electoral innovations at local government elections. This period of time should be used to develop and debate a robust electoral modernisation strategy that would review progress, propose a new way forward and instigate a public and policy debate."

So where does all of this leave the AEA and its members? Some years ago when the late Robin Cook was Leader of the House of Commons, he talked about the general election due by around 2010 being e-enabled. The chances of that happening are no more real today than they were when he made that statement. My comment

is made more in sorrow than anger. There is no doubt that Robin Cook was both a visionary and a reformer, and the AEA welcomed the ambition behind his statement. Sadly, since that time, there has been little positive progress on which to base a modernisation policy for the future.

The AEA's current position is little different from what it was when the whole modernisation process was first mooted in the late 1990s. At that time, we said that although we would welcome any initiative that improved service for the voter and increased opportunities for participation, there had to be sufficient checks and balances in place, and the overriding principle had to be to maintain and improve public confidence in the overall system that underpins our democracy.

We have cooperated with government and the Electoral Commission in terms of the various initiatives over the past eight years or so, and we will continue to do so. In doing that, we will

seek to influence forward thinking and planning and to provide the necessary opportunities for our members to become involved with and to introduce new or developing systems that meet the above objectives. However, we will continue to measure any proposals against the principle espoused above and to argue for it at every opportunity. Currently, we are awaiting an announcement from the government on its future electoral modernisation strategy. We hope that the lessons learned over the past decade will have been taken into account in settling that strategy. One thing is certain—the AEA will be at the forefront of arguing the case from the viewpoint of both the elector and the administrator.

PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTING ELECTORAL PROCUREMENT

Overthe years, the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) has developed an extensive understanding and experience in providing technical assistance and support to the conduct of democratic elections, through either UNDP headquarters or its country offices. UNDP (previously



through UNDP/IAPSO) has become a major actor in the procurement of electoral materials, ranging from ballots and ballot boxes, to ink, stationery, and digital voter registration equipment. UNDP has recently increased its focus on the crucial pre-polling period of planning and budgeting for procurement of electoral material.

This new focus reflects a recognition that the will of the people, freely and fairly expressed through periodic and genuine elections, is the basis of the authority and legitimacy of governments—and, moreover, that by far the greatest share of an electoral budget is taken up by the procurement of electoral material and services. It also reflects the increasing concern over how public funds are being managed in general.

UNDP has reinforced the procurement function and related higher-level advisory services by establishing a Procurement Services Office (PSO) in New York and Copenhagen under the leadership of James Provenzano. Two sub-units deal directly with elections: the Special Advisory Team (SAT), covering advisory services, and the Global Procurement Unit (GPU), representing the operational arm.

Special Advisory Team on Elections

SAT Elections provides continuous assistance to UNDP country offices and electoral management bodies (EMBs) through advice and support on planning and budgeting, on-site training and, in most cases, targeted exploratory, formulation and assessment missions. The team works in close collaboration with UNDP's Bureau of Development Policy, whose governance department, under the leadership of Linda Maguire, provides fundamental political parameters and guidance for UNDP's overall direction and strategy.

SAT Elections is part of the EC-UNDP Task Force for Electoral Assistance, which focuses on supporting the electoral cycle rather than a single electoral event, including but not limited to planning, budgeting and implementing electoral assistance and providing specific guidance on project document design, resources, partnerships, evaluation and procurement.

UNDP/SAT seeks to raise awareness that procurement has a much larger scope than

Elections are often perceived as crucial milestones of progress, signs to the international donor community of political consistency and commitment to common democratic norms. However, technical assistance does not always take into consideration crucial challenges and dilemmas, such as timing and appropriate sequencing; the mechanics of elections (the electoral system); an adequate legal framework; an independent neutral electoral administration; state infrastructure to support logistics and communications; the status of political parties and the business of democratic politics (such as warring factions and their demobilization/disarmament status); and the existence of a vibrant civil society and free media. All these factors are essential for the quality of an election, and their status will form and potentially limit the involvement of UNDP/SAT.

generally acknowledged. The common understanding of procurement is limited to the purchasing of goods. However, support areas, such as capacity building of state structures, including election commissions, and support to civil society organisations and national NGOs for civic education, are all services that also require the commitment of public funds. Therefore, when these services are not covered via a programmatic

framework, they are also considered procurement activities and therefore need to go through a competitive process if UNDP is involved. Furthermore, UNDP/SAT seeks to increase the focus on ethics and professionalism in the prevoting planning and procurement phase.

In addition, UNDP/SAT will strive for critical analysis of when it makes sense and when the

environment is right to have an election, rather than pushing or supporting early elections to, for example, enable an unrealistic government agenda or an international community effort to identify a counterpart, through the ballot, for the reconstruction of the country. SAT Elections will introduce a methodology of assessing the quality of elections and electoral planning in terms of transparency and fairness from a procurement point of view—in other words, a meaningful framework for assessing the quality of the crucial pre-planning phase, which will affect the end result, as well as the credibility of UNDP.

The most commonly experienced obstacles and risks in electoral procurement preparations are the decisions on implementation methodologies, development of technical specifications and terms of reference, time constraints, insufficient budgets for procurement needs and national ownership and capacities.

Technological innovations in the administration of elections raise new issues with regards to cost effectiveness and sustainability. High-tech solutions offer the hope of credible elections with fewer possibilities for human error at lower cost. This opportunity should ideally lead to a debate on the appropriate technology for a particular country context. UNDP/SAT has noted that while

introducing new technology can reduce costs and increase sustainability in the longer term, it poses a tremendous cost for procurement of equipment. In some cases, the new technology may be used only once, and by only one public institution, unless synergies emerge in a wider institutional modernization plan. Electoral budgets are often full of funding gaps, particularly when new technologies are being introduced, and this pushes a tremendous burden onto development partners.

Acknowledging these factors, UNDP/SAT is pursuing a new procurement approach. In addition to the usual procurement of electoral equipment (as per established UNDP rules and regulations), UNDP/SAT is now examining the options of leasing electoral material and technical expertise from suppliers, or even outsourcing turn-key electoral services, for example by using a benchmark of the voter registration of a certain estimated number of people. These methodologies are being investigated, and so far suppliers seem positive towards these new concepts.

Finally, UNDP/SAT and GPU will continue to have Long Term Agreements (LTAs) for the most strategic and essential electoral materials. The purpose of the LTAs is to ensure efficiency in procurement turn-around time and to limit repetitive tendering exercises within the boundaries of UNDP procurement rules and regulations. LTAs also provide guaranteed quality assurance and quality control and the benefits of economies of scale, both in terms of products and logistics.


citizens residing abroad face unique voter registration challenges when voting as overseas absentee voters. They might not receive their ballots in time or their voted ballots might not arrive until after the deadline set by their local election officials, in which case their votes may not be counted. As a result, their right to vote is far too often compromised. Overseas Vote Foundation (OVF) provides proven tools and services to overseas and uniformed services voters and local election officials, which have effectively facilitated the franchise of hundreds of thousands of U.S. military and overseas voters.

In addition, OVF offers information services that cover the key state requirements for registration dates and deadlines, as well as a comprehensive online directory of contact information for the thousands of local election officials in the United States.

With the OVF web application, voters don't need coaching through the form completion process; forms arrive with legible and complete information; emails are captured for easier contact between local election officials; and, perhaps most importantly, voters love it!

PARTNERS WITH OVF

In partnership with the JEHT Foundation, OVF is taking an innovative step in expanding the reach of its technology by allowing election officials, citizen groups and corporations to offer OVF-hosted systems. The entire OVF software suite is offered to interested organizations (states, corporations and any other group) with their own customized design. From the voter's perspective, the services are provided by the organization, while OVF provides design, development, support, hosting

OVF's hosted system partnerships represent a significant advancement in voter outreach for the organizations that chose to use the technology to improve services to their overseas citizens.

Our new Minnesota voter services site will facilitate voting for members of the Minnesota National Guard, many of whom will be first-time military voters this year."

ALABAMA

Beth Chapman, Alabama Secretary of State, who in the near term will be launching an Alabama-specific site at Overseasfoundation.org said:

"The OVF hosted system program is an innovative program in the elections arena for boosting UOCAVA voter participation. We are excited to be at the forefront with this technology and able to offer quality voter services to Alabama's military and overseas voters."

With an OVF hosted system, each organization can run a voter help desk to manage support for their voters or can defer to OVF for help-desk support. This reduces the training and support burden on staff members. A reporting dashboard provides real-time data regarding voter registrations occurring on each hosted site. All that is required is a link from the organization's homepage to the OVF hosted system page, and voters can begin getting information or registering.

OVF is the first and only private organization that can offer a full-service, ready-to-customize overseas and military voter registration system and accompanying services to help every organization reach its goals of boosting voter participation and providing quality service.

KEEPING PACE WITH TECHNOLOGY

Keeping up with the latest technology trends can be a daunting task for election officials and even IT professionals. The rapid development of technology



makes even the latest new gadget obsolete in a matter of months. With all these changes, how can you keep current? I suggest attending events concentrating on IT and elections, using various information resources and turning to IFES.

EVENTS

Election officials can keep up with the latest trends in e-voting technology by attending conferences and workshops. I attended the World E-democracy Forum in Paris last year and found that to be an excellent opportunity to network and to see how election technology is being put into practice.

Two other notable events held recently were the Overseas Vote Foundation's recent conference in Munich, Germany, which addressed the challenges of military overseas voting and E-Voting.CC's seminar covering "Information Technology in the Electoral Process" in cooperation with the Danube University in Krems.

These and similar events are excellent opportunities to meet vendors and election officials that are implementing this technology right now. Understanding their experiences and best practices is helpful when facing decisions about the pros and cons of introducing or managing election technologies. See the sidebar for additional events that you may still attend in 2008.

INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR ELECTORAL SYSTEMS

IFES can be a resource for expert advice on election technology. IFES has worked in many countries assisting Election Management Bodies (EMBs) on planning, procuring and managing electoral technologies. Recent examples of IFES' work include efforts to implement efficient and secure computer networks that manage in-house applications as basic as e-mail to more complex voter registration databases and websites where voters can access information about candidates and assist in voter outreach. IFES also regularly convenes international experts to discuss trends and issues involving election technology at its headquarters and in collaboration with our many field offices worldwide.

UPDATE ON ELECTORAL TECHNOLOGY

In the 2007 IFES Buyers Guide, I wrote about the latest technologies in Europe and an e-voting pilot in Hamburg, Germany, using digital pen technology. A hacker organization claims to have found security flaws in the voting system. They presented a scenario where real ballots could be replaced by manually manipulated ones; however, the methods of such manipulation were not explained nor was an actual attempt to hack the system tested against the software's builtin security. Despite completing a certification processes, the solution was not considered for use in Hamburg's February 2008 local elections, due to the heightened security concerns. The co-operation between Diagramm Halbach and Anoto will continue and Anoto is still looking at the market segment of e-voting systems with interest.



E-VOTING EVENTS IN 2008
