<u>Electoral system simulation tool</u> International IDEA is looking to develop an online tool for electoral system simulations that can be used to illustrate the difference between different systems in real or fictional countries. <u>Electoral violence - early warning tools</u> As a result of recent violence surrounding recent elections - such as that in Kenya, Mongolia and Pakistan - International IDEA has begun work on identifying existing methodologies that may be used to forecast the potential for violence during the electoral cycle. Although we are aware of ongoing efforts to monitor potential violent outbreaks in a more general sense, we have but a few examples of tools that are being used to predict/prevent violence that is triggered by the electoral cycle. ... read more »


